CRIME PREVENTION TIPS

1. Always keep your vehicle locked.
2. Never leave valuables inside your car.
3. Park your car with the wheels turned towards the curb.
4. Park in a busy, well-lit area.
5. Use extra security devices if available.

SECURITY DEVICES

1. Steering wheel locking device
2. Transmission locking device
3. Alarm system
4. Time-delay ignition
5. Fuel shut-off
6. Locking gas cap

RESIDENTIAL SECURITY TIPS

1. Leave exterior lights on at night.
2. Trim bushes away from windows and walkway.
3. Use charlie bars on sliding glass doors.
4. Use deadbolt locks.
5. When out of town, notify a member of your NHW
who will collect your mail and trash cans and watch
your property.
