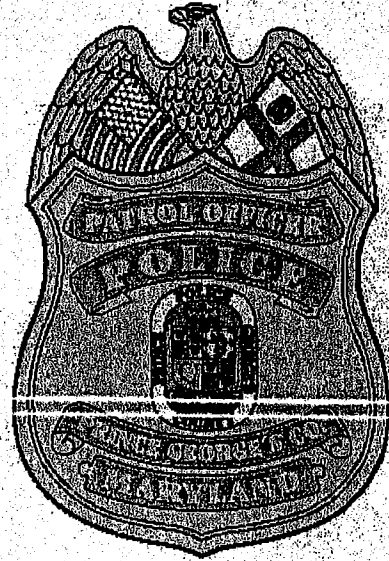


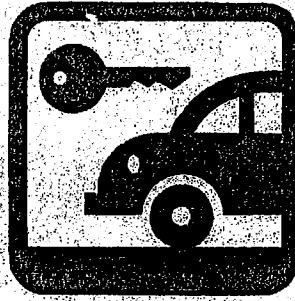

Common Sense is Your Best Defense

- Lock your car.
- Take your keys.
- Park in well-lighted areas.
- Never leave your car running unattended. Vehicles are commonly stolen at ATMs, convenience stores, etc...
- Don't leave valuables in plain view.

Investing In Vehicle Protection

- Ignition kill switches prevent the engine from starting.
- Fuel kill switches halt the fuel supply.
- Visible steering wheel locks prevent the steering wheel from being turned.

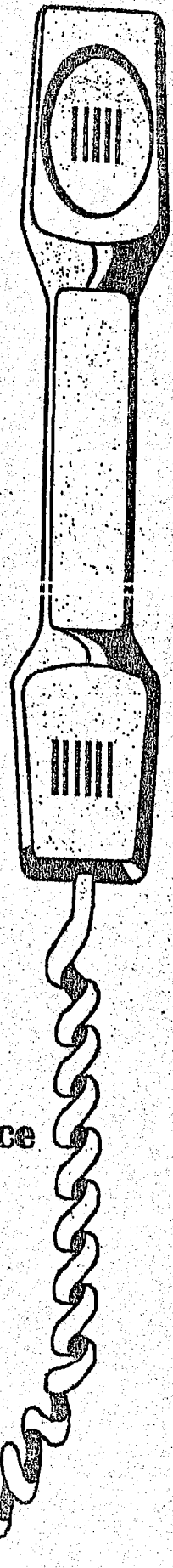



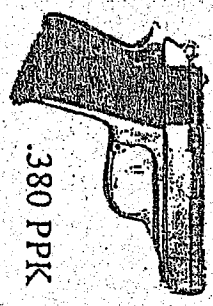
INFORMATION MOST OFTEN NEEDED BY POLICE

- ✓ **What Happened?**
- ✓ **When did it happen?**
- ✓ **Where did it happen?**
- ✓ **Was anyone injured?**
- ✓ **Vehicle license number and vehicle description**
- ✓ **Direction of travel**
- ✓ **Description of person(s) including clothing. Notice age, race, sex, gender, height and weight if safe. Compare your own weight and height with the person(s). Pick out any unique characteristics such as, scars, tattoo's, and/or jewelry, that will help you identify the person in the future if necessary.**

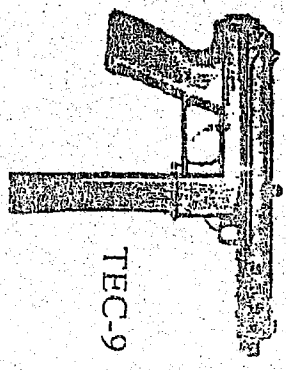

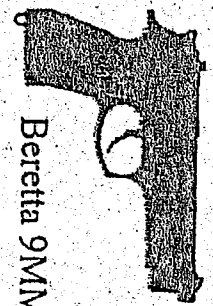
